

Dear Parents and Guardians,

Due to the abrupt closing of our school district last Friday, we will be conducting a pickup distribution of student instructional materials (books, workbooks, packets of work, etc.) this Thursday, March 19, from 1:00 pm to 7:00 pm. This is for those students that do not have devices or internet access or if your child's teacher specifically instructed you to pick up a paper packet.

It is very important that you plan to pick up these materials on Thursday between 1:00 pm and 7:00 pm by reporting to the main office of your child's school.

If your child is in grades K-5 we ask that a parent pick up the materials. The materials will be located on tables in the front lobby by grade level.

If your child is in grades 6-8 and your child has a chromebook, charger, and internet access, you do not have to come in to get materials. All of your child's assignments will be digital. If your child does not have a device or internet access, you will need to come in to pick up packets of work that will be located on the tables outside of the middle school office.

Students (or parents) in grades 9-12 can go to their locker to remove all materials. Digital assignments will be utilized whenever possible. If your child does not have a device or internet access, you will need to come in to pick up packets of work that will be located on the tables outside of the high school office.

This pickup process will not require social interaction. We ask that only one person comes in to pick up the materials, and we ask that all involved practice social distancing while in the school building. Once you are in possession of the materials, we ask that you exit the buildings immediately.

Thank you all for your understanding and cooperation during this period of national concern. We believe that there is a high potential that this shutdown may extend beyond the two week period and we want our children to have any and all opportunities to continue learning.
