

## Parking Regulations (High School Only)



Students who wish to drive their vehicle to school, need to read and be prepared to adhere to the following guidelines for parking in the high school zoned parking areas.

## 1 st

<u>Registration</u> – All vehicles driven to school and parked on school property must be registered with a parking sticker. You may obtain your pass through the High School Office. This applies also to vehicles driven only occasionally. The parking pass requires you to park in your designated numbered spot.

There are only 80 parking passes/ spaces available and these are given out on the following days:

- Seniors may secure their parking pass on August 31, 2022. Ms. Houck will be around to homerooms and first period classes. DO NOT come early and DO NOT come to the office.
- Juniors may secure their parking pass on September 1, 2022. Ms. Houck will be around to homerooms and first period classes. DO NOT come early and DO NOT come to the office.

## 2nd

<u>Registration Day</u> - Please come prepared with <u>ALL</u> *items listed* or you will be turned away and your space will NOT be held.

- √ Valid Pennsylvania driver's license (paper permits not accepted)
- ✓ Vehicle registration
- ✓ Proof of insurance
- ✓ Registration paper (Half slip) with license number and identification information completely filled out. If this page is not complete you will be asked to step out of line and complete it correctly. Don't be that person!

## 3rd

<u>Driving to school is a privilege.</u> So please make certain you meet the following criteria before applying for a parking space. Individuals registering must meet these criteria. If they do not, they will have to forfeit their space until the requirements are met.

- ✓ Students must be in good standing and have no fines or payments that are due.
- ✓ Students must not be failing or have failed any classes in the previous school year.
- ✓ Students must maintain a 2.8 GPA throughout the school year.

Students may lose parking privileges if suspended from school, are warned for dangerous driving in the parking lot area, or do not comply with the Driving to School guidelines in the student handbook.

- Students not receiving a parking pass at the beginning of the school year may place their name on a
  waiting list. Space will be given out to those students as they become available throughout the school
  year.
- Students are <u>discouraged from parking on Wakefield Drive and in Georgetown Apartments</u>. Your car may be towed by a homeowner or management at your expense. We need to work with our neighbor's to ensure a positive relationship.
- All Rules regarding smoking, weapons, drugs, alcohol, etc. which apply in school, also apply in the student parking lot and vehicles.
